It's cardboard. It's made of layers<sup>6</sup> of paper, so it's thick<sup>7</sup> and hard<sup>8</sup>. It's used for boxes.

It's a lemon press<sup>2</sup>. It's used<sup>3</sup> for squeezing<sup>4</sup> lemons to make juice. This one is made of plastic, but they can also be made of metal<sup>5</sup>.
