
We need fresh water** to drink and to water our gardens and fields. Tree roots⁷ are filters. They clean the rainwater and stop the ground absorbing it too quickly. This helps to prevent flooding8.

Climate

There is too much carbon dioxide in the air and the planet gets warmer and warmer. But trees can help! They absorb carbon dioxide into their trunks9, branches10 and leaves11***.

We need trees to be healthy. They give us food to eat, wood to burn¹² and to build homes, and they clean up the air and water. They are also home to lots of animals.
