? How do you play handball?
(.2. There are two teams and two goals ${ }^{2}$. We usually play in a sports hall with a handball ball. You throw the ball to the other players in your team. You can use your hands, head, chest ${ }^{3}$ or knees. But you cannot kick the ball with your feet. There is a 6 -metre zone in front of each goal. Only the goalkeeper ${ }^{4}$ can be inside. When you want to score ${ }^{5}$ a goal, you throw the ball from outside this zone. Each game has two 30-minute periods ${ }^{6}$.

? How often do you go to handball
? Why do you like playing handball? practice?
... My good friend plays handball, too. And it's a good sport to make new friends. I also like handball training camps. But I don't like getting up early in the morning when we go to a tournament...
? How many players are there in a team?
... There is one goalkeeper, two wingers ${ }^{7}$, and two or three backs ${ }^{8}$. But there can be 15 children, boys and girls, in one team. They don't play all the time - some players wait on the bench ${ }^{9}$ to take their turn ${ }^{10}$.
? What is your role in the team?
... I'm usually a winger, but sometimes I'm a back, too.
? How do you win a game?
.. The team that scores the most* goals wins the game.
? What do you need to play handball?
... The ball, a T-shirt, skirt or shorts, and indoor sports shoes. You can also wear elbow ${ }^{11}$ and knee pads ${ }^{12}$.
